In an endeavor to promote apprenticeship in India, a new scheme, National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) has been launched by the Government in August 2016. The scheme entails financial support to establishments undertaking apprenticeship programs.

Govt. College, Bhuna (fatehabad) provides training to the apprentices in the trade of COPA (Computer Operator and Programming Assistant) and Stenographer (Hindi). Apprentices get an opportunity of undergoing on the job' training and are exposed to real working conditions. The college provides training of one year to the apprentices. In addition, apprentices get stipends at the prescribed rates during training.
