Purpose : Memorandum of Understanding

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (here in after called as the 'MOU') is entered on the 20 May of 2025.

BETWEEN

Government College Bhuna, Fatehabad the First Party represented here in by its Name of Competent Authority/Representative (hereinafter referred as '**First Party**', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in- office, administrators and assigns).

AND

Bharat Vikas Parishad Bhuna, Fatehabad, the Second Party, and represented herein by its founder, Name of Competent Authority/Representative, (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", parishad which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant the subject or context shall include its successors–in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are here in after jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

- 1) First Party & Second Party will collaborate to promote effective use of mutual resources for enhanced understanding of the students towards society and natural resources.
- 2) The parties intend to cooperate with each other for educational and nature trips, social awareness drives, seminars and ensuring a concerned social growth of the students.

BACKGROUND OF PARTIES

Government College Bhuna, Fatehabad

Government College Bhuna, Fatehabad is a co-educational Degree College. It was established in July-2015. The purpose of setting up of this college in this rural area was to bring the students of this educationally backward area to the main stream by providing higher education to its youth, especially the girls. The College is affiliated to Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Sirsa. The first academic session of the college started in July 2015 with three streams, namely *Arts, Commerce and Science (Non-Medical)*. In 2021, M.Com, M.A. in Hindi and M.A. in English subject also started and the college has become a post graduate. The College campus consists of 16 classrooms, 7 laboratories, 1 smart-room, 1 library, 1 auditorium, office and a beautiful green campus. At present 1328 students are enrolled in all classes. The faculty of the College consists of 20 highly qualified, well-experienced teacher. There are 11 non-teaching staff also that is very dedicated in their own field.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE - 1 Co-operation

Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing a sustainable approach towards environment and society keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.

The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU.

CLAUSE - 2 Scope of the MOU

The Geography budding graduates from the institutions can play a key role in a social welfare organization. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student

community to enhance their skills and knowledge in the educational, social, environmental, ecology and cultural field. The real experiences of the society would make them concerned and kind human beings.

Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party enhancing their skill set and promoting their overall growth.

Training & Visits:

Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest working culture in the field of social and environmental issues/requirements of the Institution; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to join educational and nature trips and also involve in campaigns for the First Party. The training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career and would help them to understand the needs of society. The First party will provide its Volunteers / Workshops / Work Sites for the hands-on training of the volunteers enrolled with second party.

Internships and Placement of Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs.

Research and Development: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of – **Education and Training.**

Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party to communicate and understand the problems of the society. This type of interaction would make them compassionate and would give them confidence to chase their dreams and bring change. **Expert Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver expert lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

Faculty Development Programs: Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting industrial exposure/training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

Startups/Entrepreneurship: The second party will assist/guide the students for setting their own start-ups and further will help them to be entrepreneur in their respective areas.

There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Government College Bhuna**, the First Party, to take up any activity mentioned in the

MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE - 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE - 4 VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid initially for a period of 2 years. It can be extended further with mutual consent.

Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the vent of Termination, both parties have to discharge their existing obligations.

CLAUSE - 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as in dependent entities and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

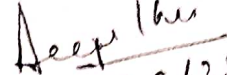

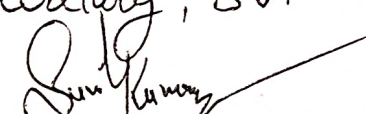
